HARD DIVIDER BOARD PROGRAM

The Wisconsin Amateur Hockey Association (WAHA) is starting a Grant Program to aid our community based hockey associations and their home rinks in advancing the cross-ice hockey for 8U players. The program offers a \$2,500 subsidy to nine WAHA Hockey affiliated associations who apply and are drawn at the WAHA Annual Meeting on August 3. However, if more than nine associations apply previous winners will be removed from the drawing. The deadline to apply is July 15, 2019.

Eligibility

All WAHA hockey associations are eligible to apply by completing the attached form. The grant applications will be drawn at the WAHA Annual Meeting on August 3, Jefferson Inn, Wausau, WI.

Requirements

Associations awarded a grant must commit to purchasing one set of “hard divider” boards through WAHA. The association will be responsible for paying \$5,400 to WAHA for a 85’ Long System or \$6,400 for a 100’ Long System plus shipping. The total cost for a 85’ Long System is \$7,900 and for the 100’ Long System is \$8,900 and will be covered in part by the WAHA Grant. As a component of the subsidy, the boards may include logos of WAHA and its corporate partners. **Note: If we give out 9 grants the shipping will be free.**

Payment

Payment will be made as follows: Association names that are drawn at the WAHA Annual Meeting in Wausau on Saturday, August 3, 2019 will make payment of the \$5,400 or \$6,400 on or before September 1, 2019. Once payment is received the boards will be ordered through Rink Systems (see attached sheet for specifics) and shipped to your rink when the order is completed. **NOTE: If payment is not received by September 1, the grant will be awarded to another association.**
